According to the process for collecting information on international trade and use, adopted by the Chemical Review Committee, we would like to inform the situation in Brazil.

<b>Chemical</b>	<b>Situation</b>
<b>Pesticides</b> under rules as Federal Law nº 7.802, of 11 of July 1989 and Decree nº 4.074, of 4 of January 2002, besides other administrative acts emitted by Ministry of Agriculture, Ministry of Health and Ministry of Environment.	
Azinphos-methyl	No product registered.
Paraquat	5 (five) registered herbicides. The substance is manufactured and formulated in the country.
Methyl parathion	7 (seven) acaricides/insecticides registered. The substance is formulated in the country.
Mirex (Dodecacloro)	Prohibited by the Administrative Act nº 91/1992 emitted by Ministry of Agriculture.
Phorate	1 (one) insecticide registered. The substance is manufactured and formulated in the country.
<b>Industrial Use</b>	
Hexachlorobenzene	Substance not in trade or use in the country.
Hexachlorobutadiene	Substance not in trade or use in the country.
