Item 4**Review of the outcomes of the seventh meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Rotterdam Convention relevant to the work of the Committee**

7. The seventh meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Rotterdam Convention on the Prior Informed Consent Procedure for Certain Hazardous Chemicals and Pesticides in International Trade was held in Geneva, from 4 to 15 May 2015, back to back with the twelfth meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Basel Convention on the Control of Transboundary Movements of Hazardous Wastes and Their Disposal and the seventh meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants. The outcomes of the meetings relevant to the work of the Committee are described in document UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/INF/4. The Committee may wish to take note of the information provided and consider any further action.

Item 5**Technical work****(a) Consideration of draft decision guidance documents****(i) Short-chained chlorinated paraffins**

8. The Committee will have before it a note by the Secretariat containing a draft decision guidance document for short-chained chlorinated paraffins, available in the six official languages of the United Nations (UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/2). A tabular summary of comments on the draft decision guidance document is available in document UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/INF/7. The Committee may wish to finalize the draft decision guidance document and to forward it, along with its recommendation to list short-chained chlorinated paraffins in Annex III to the Convention as industrial chemicals, for consideration by the Conference of the Parties at its eighth meeting.

(ii) Tributyltin compounds

9. The Committee will have before it a note by the Secretariat containing a draft decision guidance document for tributyltin compounds, available in the six official languages of the United Nations (UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/3). A tabular summary of comments on the draft decision guidance document is available in document UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/INF/8. The Committee may wish to finalize the draft decision guidance document and to forward it, along with its recommendation to list tributyltin compounds in Annex III to the Convention as industrial chemicals, for consideration by the Conference of the Parties at its eighth meeting.

(b) Report of the Bureau on the preliminary review of notifications of final regulatory action and the proposal for a severely hazardous pesticide formulation

10. The Committee will have before it a note by the Secretariat setting out the report of the Bureau on the preliminary review of notifications of final regulatory action and the proposal for a severely hazardous pesticide formulation (UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/4). In addition, information on trade in chemicals under consideration by the Chemical Review Committee and a summary record of notifications of final regulatory action for chemicals reviewed by the Interim Chemical Review Committee and the Chemical Review Committee are available in documents UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/INF/5 and UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/INF/6, respectively. The Committee may wish to consider the results of the preliminary review by the Bureau in the context of the establishment of the task groups recommended therein.

(c) Review of notifications of final regulatory action**(i) Atrazine**

11. The Committee will have before it a note by the Secretariat containing notifications of final regulatory action relating to atrazine from two prior informed consent regions: Europe (the European Union) and Africa (Cabo Verde, Chad, the Gambia, Mauritania, the Niger, Senegal and Togo) (UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/5). The supporting documentation provided by the European Union and by Cabo Verde, Chad, the Gambia, Mauritania, the Niger, Senegal and Togo is set out in documents UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/INF/9 and UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/INF/10, respectively. The Committee may wish to take note of the information provided in those documents and consider the action proposed in document UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/5.

(ii) Carbofuran

12. The Committee will have before it a note by the Secretariat containing notifications of final regulatory action relating to carbofuran from three prior informed consent regions: Europe (European Union), North America (Canada) and Africa (Cabo Verde, Chad, the Gambia, Mauritania, the Niger, Senegal and Togo) (UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/6). The supporting documentation provided by the European Union, by Canada and by Cabo Verde, Chad, the Gambia, Mauritania, the Niger, Senegal and Togo is set out in documents UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/INF/11, UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/INF/12 and UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/INF/13, respectively. The Committee may wish to review the information provided in those documents and consider the action proposed in document UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/6.

(iii) Carbosulfan

13. The Committee will have before it a note by the Secretariat containing notifications of final regulatory action relating to carbosulfan from two prior informed consent regions: Europe (European Union) and Africa (Burkina Faso, Cabo Verde, Chad, the Gambia, Mauritania, the Niger, Senegal and Togo) (UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/7). The supporting documentation provided by the European Union and by Burkina Faso, Cabo Verde, Chad, the Gambia, Mauritania, the Niger, Senegal and Togo is set out in documents UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/INF/14 and UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/INF/15, respectively. The Committee may wish to review the information provided in those documents and consider the action proposed in document UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/7.

(d) Review of the proposal for the inclusion of dimethoate emulsifiable concentrate 400 g/L as a severely hazardous pesticide formulation in Annex III

14. The Committee will have before it a note by the Secretariat containing a proposal for the inclusion of dimethoate emulsifiable concentrate 400 g/L as a severely hazardous pesticide formulation in Annex III submitted by Georgia (UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/8). Information on dimethoate emulsifiable concentrate 400 g/L collected by the Secretariat in accordance with part 2 of Annex IV to the Rotterdam Convention is set out in document UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/INF/16. The Committee may wish to take note of the information provided in those documents and consider the action proposed in document UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.11/8.
