**Subject: Call for information and follow-up to the decisions adopted by the Conference of the Parties to the Rotterdam Convention at its ninth meeting (Geneva, Switzerland from 29 April to 10 May 2019)**

At its ninth meeting, the Conference of the Parties to the Rotterdam Convention adopted a number of decisions that invited Parties and others to provide information. The full set of decisions adopted at the meeting are contained in Annex I to the meeting report, which will be made available on the Rotterdam Convention website: [www.pic.int](http://www.pic.int). To facilitate your response to the various invitations for information, please find enclosed a summary of the individual decisions.

Please note that similar letters have also been sent to Parties and observers for the decisions adopted by the conferences of the Parties to the Basel and Stockholm conventions. The invitations for information contained in three of the joint decisions adopted by the three conferences of the Parties have been included in each of the individual letters.

In decisions RC-9/3 and RC-9/4, the Conference of the Parties to the Rotterdam Convention agreed to list hexabromocyclododecane and phorate in Annex III to the Convention. A separate letter will be sent to solicit your import responses for those chemicals, at the time the amendments to list them in Annex III to the Convention enter into force on 16 September 2019.

## **Follow-up to the decisions adopted by the Conference of the Parties to the Rotterdam Convention at its ninth meeting**

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## **1. Status of implementation of the Convention**

Decision: RC-9/1: Status of implementation of the Convention

Background:

At the ninth meeting of the Conference of the Parties, Parties were encouraged, among other things, to adopt, as soon as possible, a national definition for the term “pesticide”, should they not yet have done so, and communicate the national definitions for the term “pesticide” to the Secretariat; to provide the Secretariat with information that may assist other Parties to prepare and notify final regulatory actions; and to provide information on their implementation of paragraph 2 of Article 11, and Articles 12 and 14 of the Convention by submitting responses to the periodic questionnaire on the implementation of those articles. The Conference of the Parties also invited Parties, non-Parties, civil society and other stakeholders to provide to the Secretariat data on the international trade in chemicals listed or recommended for listing in Annex III to the Convention; as well as information on the measurable impact of listing chemicals in Annex III to the Convention.

## **2. Consideration of acetochlor for listing in Annex III to the Rotterdam Convention**

Decision: RC-9/5: Consideration of acetochlor for listing in Annex III to the Rotterdam Convention

Background:

At its ninth meeting, the Conference of the Parties decided that the requirements for listing acetochlor in Annex III to the Convention had been met, but was not able to reach consensus on whether to list the chemical in Annex III to the Convention. The Conference of the Parties encouraged Parties to make use of all available information on acetochlor to assist others, in particular developing-country Parties and Parties with economies in transition, to make informed decisions regarding the import and management of acetochlor and to inform other Parties of those decisions using the information exchange provisions laid down in Article 14 of the Convention.

To facilitate such information exchange, Parties can submit this information to the Secretariat who will share it through the PIC Circular.

Decision: RC-9/12: Synergies in preventing and combating illegal traffic and trade in hazardous chemicals and wastes

Background:

In decision RC-9/12, the Conference of the Parties, among other things, encouraged Parties that have not yet done so to establish national-level coordination mechanisms with a view to facilitating the exchange of information among relevant authorities responsible for the implementation and enforcement of the provisions of the Basel, the Rotterdam Convention and the Stockholm Convention aimed at controlling the export and import of the chemicals and wastes covered under the conventions, and encouraged Parties to provide information to the Secretariat about cases of illegal traffic and trade in the chemicals and wastes covered by the Basel, Rotterdam and Stockholm conventions, where the provision of such information is appropriate under existing reporting procedures.
