Lambda-cyhalothrin capsule suspension 50 g/L: information collected by the Secretariat

Note by the Secretariat

1. As indicated in document UNEP/FAO/RC/CRC.13/17, the Secretariat received a proposal from Georgia to list lambda-cyhalothrin capsule suspension 50 g/L as a severely hazardous pesticide formulation in Annex III to the Rotterdam Convention. In accordance with paragraph 3 of Article 6 of the Convention, the Secretariat collected from Parties and observers the additional information set out in part 2 of Annex IV to the Convention regarding the proposal.
2. The Secretariat received information from the following Parties: Canada, Central African Republic, Chile, Ecuador, European Union and its member States, Mexico, Paraguay, Republic of Moldova, Senegal, Serbia, Switzerland, United Arab Emirates; and from two observers: World Health Organization and Pesticide Action Network International.
3. The information received is set out in the annex to the present note. The present note, including its annex, has not been formally edited.
